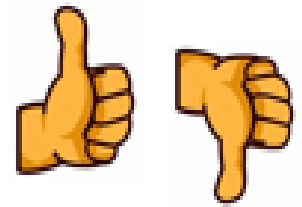


Paragraph checklist Psychology
